3a. NHS Leadership Essay (15 points)

Each candidate for membership in National Honor Society is required to compose a 500-word essay that demonstrates his or her leadership skills. Essays will be included in the candidate application packet, and will be evaluated by a panel of teachers for content, completion, and adherence to the requirements listed below.

The essay should describe a specific project or task for which the candidate served as the person in charge, and explain what the candidate learned from participating in the activities described, or how the candidate has grown as an individual as a result of his or her participation. The essay should be typed in *twelve-point font* and double-spaced.

In order to be accepted for membership in the Howard High School Chapter of the National Honor Society, candidates must score a minimum of <u>36 out of 47 points</u> on the above rubric and may <u>NOT score a total of zero (0) in any of the three categories.</u>

Packets that are not approved due to missing or incomplete components will NOT be eligible to appeal the final decision.

Candidates who have been accepted for membership will receive a letter notifying them of their acceptance and providing additional instructions.

Candidates who are not accepted for membership will also receive a letter notifying them that they did not meet the criteria for membership. The letter will include an explanation of the decision Appeal Process.
