HOWARD HIGH SCHOOL DRIVING AND PARKING LOT REGULATIONS

STUDENT INITIAL	THERE IS A \$15.00 FEE FOR THE PRIVILEGE OF PARKING ON SCHOOL PROPERTY
1.	The student and a parent/guardian must attend a Safety Program prior to receiving a permit.
2.	All automobiles must be registered with the Administration.
3.	The permit must be displayed hanging from the rear view mirror when the car is parked on school property.
4.	Permission to drive to school covers the driver only and does not include transporting other students UNLESS parent authorization has been given by parent/guardian of both the driver and the passenger.
5.	State laws concerning safe driving will be enforced. Buses and pedestrians have the right of way at all times.
6.	Students will park ONLY in white lined spaces which are located in the parking lot in front of the building and the lot adjacent to the gymnasium. DO NOT park in the first THREE rows in the parking lot in front of the building. These are reserved for staff members and emergency vehicles only. Students parking without a valid permit will be assigned disciplinary consequences for disrupting school operations.
7.	Student drivers are NOT to go to their vehicles during the school day. If a student must go to his/her car during the school day, it must be approved in writing by the front office.
8.	The school assumes no responsibility for vehicles on Board of Education property.
9.	The student driver should immediately notify the school of any changes of vehicles. The driver will also immediately notify the school of any change in license plate numbers.
10.	If a permit is lost, the student must secure a new permit at a fee of \$15.00.
11.	The permit that is issued is for the assigned vehicle(s) only. It is not to be traded or sold to other drivers. The permit number and vehicle license number must agree with the school's records or the permit will be revoked immediately.
12.	Students MUST OBEY all signs/arrows in the parking lot and all rules and regulations governing parking on school grounds. Failure to do so may result in parking privileges being revoked.
13.	Students who are tardy and/or leave the school grounds during the school day without authorization will be subject to having their parking privileges being revoked.
